



# WASHINGTON COUNTY OREGON

## 2010-2011 Road Maintenance Work Program Summary

- 15.4 miles of asphalt overlay on major county roads
- 7.6 miles of asphalt overlay on local streets in the Urban Road Maintenance District
- 25.0 miles of slurry seal on local streets in the Urban Road Maintenance District
- 23.3 miles of chip sealing, including 0.7 miles of gravel road upgrades
- 5.6 miles of machine patch road repairs
- 0.4 miles of property-owner financed paving
- 319.0 miles of shoulder maintenance
- 210.2 miles of gravel road maintenance, plus about 13.6 miles of gravel road stabilization (dust control)
- 54 bridge maintenance projects
- 3 cross culvert replacements
- 425.5 shoulder miles of roadside ditching
- 444.9 miles of roadways striped, plus 34.9 miles of contracted striping
- 190 school and railroad crossing stencils, plus 123 thermal plastic installation locations (crosswalks)
- 15,072 raised pavement marker installations
- 449 traffic signals maintained
- 725.7 shoulder miles of brush cutting and chipping
- 1.5 million square feet of shoulder and landscape mowing
- 49.1 shoulder miles of vegetation maintenance for next year's URMD surface treatments
- 42.8 miles of roadside landscape maintenance (provided primarily by community service workers)
- 1,216.3 shoulder miles of herbicide application to control roadside vegetation
- Plus other road surface, bridge, drainage, traffic, and vegetation activities

## Washington County Road System Facts (as of January 2010)

- 1,271 total centerline miles of roadway
  - 1,048 miles paved, 223 miles unpaved
  - 633 miles urban, 638 miles rural
- Pavement condition:
  - 64% Very good
  - 34% Good
  - 2% Fair
  - <1% Poor
- 189 bridges
- 3,035 culverts
- 883 miles of ditches
- 32 miles of guardrail
- 166 miles of sidewalk
- 449 traffic signals
- over 10,000 street lights
